We are here to serve the community and one another, in an atmosphere of fun - it is important to laugh and have a good fellowship together. We have one service each Sunday at 10.30am

- 3rd Sunday** Holy Communion
- 4th Sunday** Informal Morning Worship

On the 5th Sunday, we have Guest/Invitation services. This enables us to have variety and provide a worship pattern to meet different needs.

We share a Youth Leader with churches in Hampton-in-Arden and Balsall Common, and we want and are praying for more young families and children to join us.



We regularly visit each home in the village through 'Say 1 4 Me'... simply asking folk if there are any people/issues they would like us as a church to pray for. It is an opportunity for bridge-building, the church going to the people in an unthreatening manner.

We focus on good Bible teaching and have Cell Groups that meet at different times during the week.



Occasionally we run Alpha Courses covering the subject of Christianity - Is it boring - untrue - irrelevant.

We enjoy ourselves and have an active social life, with regular Men's and Ladies Suppers and monthly Family Lunches on the second Sunday of each month - all in St Swithin's House next to the Church.

We support and have links with Missionary Societies in various parts of the world. The societies that we currently support are - Church Pastoral Aid Society (CPAS), Tear Fund, Church Missionary Society (CMS), Bible Society, and Children's Homes in India Trust (CHITS).
